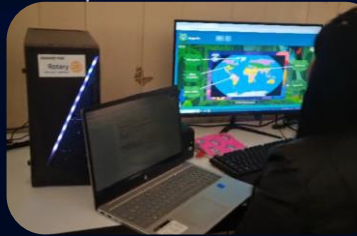

2. Training for teachers

We develop teachers skills in using digital tools to make their planning easier and faster, while making their classes more fun and engaging by integrating relevant actions and activities.



3. What we do for the community Schools

We partner with schools in underserved communities where parents and teachers are committed to improving education.

Despite limited resources, we provide 15-20 computers, with monitors, mice, voltage regulators, Windows licenses, tables and chairs, Internet access and security alarm for the computer room.

We train all the teachers on how to use the platform effectively. so, they can get the most benefit and help develop their students' skills.

The community is grateful, teachers are engaged, and children are excited about learning. With a small investment, we can make a significant impact on childhood development.

In our first project, we benefited more than 300 children. The impact on the number of beneficiaries is substantial.
